Literacy- Bug day-wormery, visit another country day, designing an outfit, drama activities, exploring different settings and green screen in ICT.

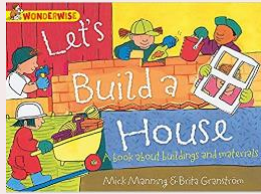
Topic- Dinosaur Visit, dinosaur hunt, clay modelling and fossil dig.

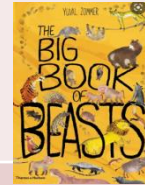
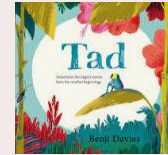
Literacy- Africa experience, using their senses to explore colours, animal experience and poetry performance.
