Topic-Pirate treasure hunt, pirate dress up ,pirate portraits and making moving pictures.

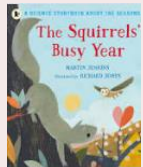

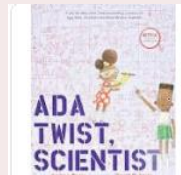
