

**Dear Parents and Carers,**

We are entering into our final three weeks of the year now and I wanted to just update you on some transition and end of year logistics.

**Transition to next year group**

Staff are completing the class lists for next academic year and we will be sharing these with you as parents on Friday 12th July. You will receive an email from ParentPay at approximately 4.30pm on that Friday. Please do check any junk email folders if you do not receive this email to your inbox. If you do not receive this email, please email the school office on [stmonicas.admin@trafford.gov.uk](mailto:stmonicas.admin@trafford.gov.uk) over that weekend and the office will make sure you receive that as soon as possible.

On Tuesday 16th July, children will attend their current classes for Registration and will then be brought to their new classes that they will be in during academic year 2024/25.

Year 1 have completed their Phonics Screening check and Year 4 have completed their Multiplication check. Scores from these will be included alongside the end of year reports.

Extra transition sessions will be offered to those children who we feel need that extra transition. If you have concerns about your child's transition, please do get in touch with us.

**Reports**

End of Year Reports will be sent home with children on Friday 12th July. **We ask that you do not open these on the school playground at the end of the day but open them at home. If there are any follow up issues, you will be able to contact school on Monday 15th July.**

**Stay and Read Morning**

There is another opportunity for parents/carers to come and spend some time with your children in school with our Stay and Read Morning. After you drop your children off and children are registered in class, staff will open the doors of their classroom for parents/carers to come and spend some time with their children reading for about 25/30 mins. Hopefully we will see lots of you there.

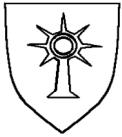

Attendance figures for this week 94.25%, still below our 97% target. Well done to 5/6B with there high of **98.62%**.

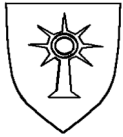
